



Candidate/Certified Person Appeals Application

An appeal is a formal request to the National Doula Certification Board for any individuals who want to get special consideration of accommodation related to their certification status. The person appealing must have a sound rationale regarding the need to be considered by the board for special consideration to be awarded. Also, an appeal is not an avenue for requesting a passing score on a failed exam. This form must be submitted within 30 days of decision/incident.
